Notice of Annual Meeting of the Norfolk Sewer District, Norfolk, CT 06058

To the inhabitants of the Norfolk Sewer District in the Town of Norfolk, Connecticut, legally qualified to vote in said District:

You are hereby notified and warned that the Annual Meeting of the Norfolk Sewer District in the Town of Norfolk will be held at the Town Hall, 19 Maple Avenue, Norfolk, CT on Wednesday, May 16, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. for the following purposes, to wit:

1. To approve the minutes from the Annual Meeting of May 2017
2. To receive the reports of the various Officers and Committees
3. To adopt a budget
4. Lay the tax defining percentage of the budget (45%) for Unit Fee; (55%) for Usage Fee
5. Fix the tax rates for Unit Fee (dividing 45% of the budget by the number of Units in the District) and Usage Fee (dividing 55% of the budget by the meter readings from the Water Company servicing the District) for the gallonage used from October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017
6. To vote to accept the proposal from the United States Department of Agriculture – Rural Development to receive a 40% Grant and a 60% Loan at 2.125% for a period of 40 years to fund a \$4,201,000 project to rehabilitate the Sewer Collection System in order to comply with the Consent Order issued by the State of Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection on May 6, 2011.
7. To eliminate the Usage Fee Charge for those inhabitants in the District who are not directly attached to the collection system.
8. To enact on any other business proper to come before this meeting.
