Work on Cemeteries:

Mapping: The cemetery are currently be mapped. Vito Ruggiero of New England Subsurface Imaging is doing the ground penetrating radar work and marking graves in the (3) town cemeteries. Carmine Matrascia is taking the data from Vito and is working on the maps.

Tree Work: Nature Own Tree Company has been contacted to trim or remove the large maple at the back of the South Norfolk Cemetery

Masonry Work South Norfolk Cemetery: The Norfolk Public Works Department is working on capping the pillars, re-pointing the walls & repairing the footing under the pillar at the left front of the cemetery.

Washed out driveway at Grantville Cemetery – Completed.


Painting of fence at Pod town Cemetery – to be completed this summer
