

**NORFOLK BOARD OF FINANCE  
MINUTES OF MAY 28, 2020 ANNUAL BUDGET HEARING AND SPECIAL MEETING**

Members present were: M. Sconyers, G. Allyn, G. Mudge; N. Ritson, J. Tarrant and D. Torrey.

Alternate members present were: S. Anderson; L. Battis and A. Bennett.

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by M. Sconyers.

No Public comment was received prior to or during the meeting.

M. Sconyers reported regarding Region 7's budget that there was originally a reduction of \$225,879 to Norfolk, the new reduction assessment is going down by approximately \$232,685. Accordingly, the First Selectman is reducing the draw from the Positive Fund Balance.

Nothing changed in the Town's Budget and there were no further changes to the Botelle Board of Education's budget.

The Budget will result in a 25.98 mill assessment for the coming year, which is 1 mill less than last year.

M. Sconyers entertained a motion to approve the Town's Budget as modified, on a Motion by G. Allyn, second by N. Ritson and unanimously approved.

The Annual Budget Hearing adjourned at 6:09 p.m.

The Special Meeting came to order at 6:09 p.m.

The only purpose of the Special Meeting was to set the Mill Rate for the coming year at 25.98.

On a Motion by M. Sconyers to set the Mill Rate at 25.98, second by D. Torrey, the motion was unanimously approved.

M. Sconyers will notify the Tax Collector of the new Mill Rate.

On Motion of D. Torrey, second by J. Tarrant and unanimously approved, the meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
