Annual Sticker

\$60 first vehicle
\$40 second vehicle

Vehicles **MUST** be registered at the same address, in order to qualify for discount.

Bulky Waste

\$25 per ticket

Passenger car	1 ticket
1/2 & 3/4 ton pickup	2 tickets
1 ton pickup	4 tickets
1 ton dump truck	6 tickets
Up to 6' long trailer	2 tickets
Truck/trailer over 1 ton	4 tickets/cubic yard

Bulky waste is construction or demolition debris (such as sheet rock or shingles), large furniture, or anything that can't be burned. Partial loads or other non-standard loads will be charged accordingly by the attendant.

Bricks, concrete, stone, asphalt, propane tanks, stumps and logs are **NOT ACCEPTED**

Tires (OFF RIM)

\$2.00 per tire

REMINDERS

New stickers are available beginning on JUNE 1 (No Earlier).

Stickers **MUST** be in place by JULY 1.

Stickers **MUST** be **PERMANENTLY** affixed to the **LOWER** corner of the windshield on the **PASSENGER** side.

Sort trash from recyclables. It saves the town (and you!) money.

Flatten cardboard and sort/separate recyclables **BEFORE** you arrive at the transfer station.

Stop at the top of the ramp **BEFORE** you enter the shed.

Only 3 vehicles in the unloading area inside the shed at one time.

Turn off your car while unloading.

Be considerate of those waiting to unload and keep the line moving. (Move your conversations outside.)

Hazardous Waste may be disposed of 2x a year. Please call the Selectman's Office 860-542-5829 for dates, times, and instructions.
