1. **Call to Order**-6:33 pm
2. **Roll Call** – Alternate West Lowe sat for Marion Felton.
3. **Agenda Review**-Michael Halloran asked to add an invoice to 8C and a referral response from NHCOG to 8D. A motion to add these items to Bills and Correspondence was made by Christopher Schaut, seconded by West Lowe, and approve unanimously.
4. **Approval of Minutes**-A motion to approve the minutes as amended for the February 9, 2021 meeting was made by West Lowe, seconded by Paul Madore, and approved unanimously.
5. **Public Comment**-none.
6. **New Business**-
 - A. Michael Halloran said he received a letter withdrawing #21-008 application. A new one will be made.
