GASOLINE TANKER ROLLOVER AND PRODUCT RELEASE UPDATE

On-site activity has slowed on Sunday with crews monitoring the collection pads and booms intermittently. All local and state roads continue to be open and accessible. We do not expect any disruptions to the high school or elementary school bus routes for Monday. Children will be picked up and dropped off at their normal locations.

Clean up and monitoring staff will be on site this coming week to continue with the progress they've achieved in a short amount of

time. However, only a small amount of the 8200 gallons of gasoline has been recovered which means much more needs to be done. Some details as to what that means will be shared on Tuesday but we can expect the recovery to continue for several more weeks, perhaps longer.
