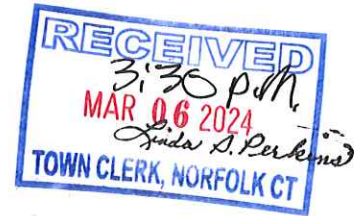


Workplace, Health & Safety Committee Meeting

*New Business*


- T. Gorski reported that the PW garage is still having problems with their phone line.
