- Botelle School Fuel Tank – The fuel tank and safety barriers have been installed and the old tank removed. Tyler will contact Perotti's to have the tank plumbed in. Troy will contact ETT to have the tank sealed.
- Botelle School – the new slide has been installed and a step system for the hill was discussed, possibly using railroad ties.
- Botelle School roof will be replaced next Spring.
- NVFD – Judy Ludwig reported that plans for the new firehouse are in progress. M. Riiska sent site recommendations to the architect this morning.

New Business


- Maple Avenue – M. Riiska reported that remediation is ongoing and is projected to go until the end of September at which time Guerrero Construction will begin rebuilding the road.
