Affidavit for Antique, Rare or Special Interest Motor Vehicle ** This form must be notarized and returned to the Assessor by December 31, 2024 for consideration of assessment change for Grand List year 2024 **

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 14-1(3), as amended by Public Act 08-150, passenger vehicles (01), combination vehicles (03), and motorcycles (12), 20 years or older that are defined as an antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Section 14-1, as amended by Public Act 08-150, Section 1, shall not be assessed at more than \$500.

<u>Definition:</u> C.G.S. Section 14-1, (3) "Antique, rare or special interest motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle twenty years old or older which is being preserved because of historic interest and which is not altered or modified from the original manufacturer's specifications.

The owner of such motor vehicle may be required by the Assessor to provide reasonable documentation, such as a photo, that such motor vehicle is an antique, rare, or special interest motor vehicle. Public Act 09-187(b).
