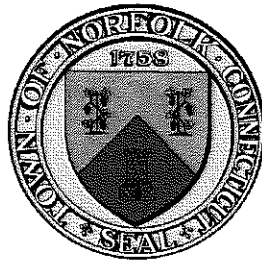

TRANSFER STATION PERMIT Permit Information and Requirements

Only Norfolk residents are eligible to purchase a
Transfer Station Permit.

Transfer Station Stickers go on sale June 1, 2023.

The fee is \$90 for the first vehicle registered to a household.
\$75 for each additional vehicle.

Stickers must be permanently affixed to the lower corner of
the windshield on the passenger side of the vehicle.
(NO switching the sticker from one vehicle to another!)

Please provide a copy of your current vehicle registration along with your
Permit Application.

FEE STRUCTURE

Annual Sticker

\$90 first vehicle

\$75 second vehicle

Vehicles **MUST** be registered at the same address, in order to qualify for discount.

Bulky Waste

\$40 per ticket

Attendant will assess number of tickets per load

Passenger car	1 ticket
1/2 ton pickup	2-4 tickets
1 ton pickup	4-5 tickets
1 ton dump truck	6 -8 tickets
Trailers & roll offs	See Attendant

ACCEPTED

Construction/demolition debris
Sheet rock & shingles
Large furniture
Anything that can't be burned.

NOT ACCEPTED

Bricks, concrete, stone, asphalt,
propane tanks, stumps & logs

Freon

\$15 per ticket

Tires (OFF RIM)

\$5.00 per tire

REMINDERS

Stickers by **JULY 1**.

Stickers **MUST** be **PERMANENTLY** affixed to the **LOWER** corner of the windshield on the **PASSENGER** side.

Sort trash from recyclables.

Flatten cardboard & sort/separate recyclables **BEFORE** you arrive at the transfer station.

Stop at the top of the ramp **BEFORE** you enter the shed.

Only **3 vehicles** in the unloading area inside the shed at one time.

Turn off your car while unloading.

Be considerate of those waiting to unload and keep the line moving. (Move your conversations outside.)

Hazardous Waste may be disposed of 2x a year. Please call the Selectman's Office 860-542-5829 for dates, times, and instructions.

Light Ballasts

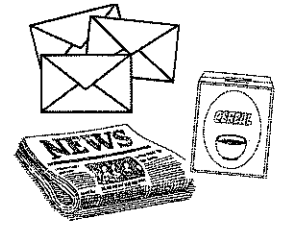
ANYTHING you aren't sure about

Municipal Solid Waste
Household Rubbish/Garbage (must be in plastic bags)
Wood 3' x 3' or smaller
SMALL furniture (remove legs please)
Latex paint cans (paint MUST be dried)

Paper & Paper Products
NO pizza boxes or shredded paper!
They go in the trash.

Newspapers
Magazines
Cardboard boxes
Cardboard rolls
Window envelopes
& food boxes w/
clear window removed

NO SHREDDED PAPER



Aluminum, Plastic & Glass

Cans
Glass
Water bottles
Aluminum foil
Spray bottles
Milk & juice containers
#1- #5 Plastic containers

NO #6 (Black) Plastic
NO Styrofoam
NO paint cans
NO pesticides
