South Norfolk Cemetery Business

- M. Riiska reported that the Town will be removing the tree behind the wall.
- J. Gundlach submitted pictures from the old section (in the front) showing a few graves with indentations up to a foot deep. M. Riiska will have public works fill them in with topsoil, or the dirt from the back of the cemetery, prior to Memorial Day.
- Easter Sunrise Service (Congregational Church) – J. Gundlach reported that a grate was left behind from their firepit. This was the first year they had a firepit but after discussion it was decided that in the future the church could have the service, but no more fires. B. Gomez will contact the church.
- J. Gundlach reported that the flat gravestone of Red & Irene Raymond (and daughter) is still missing. Not sure who would have taken it, but M. Riiska will get a price from Marchi Memorials in Winsted for a replacement. L. Perkins will research the name of the daughter for the stone.
- Granite posts – M. Riiska will get prices for 8 granite posts to mark out the first and second rows. J. Gundlach suggested putting a hole in the posts for a chain.
- The chains will remain across the old portion of the cemetery to keep out vehicle traffic. B. Gomez will order three “No Vehicle Traffic” signs for use during closure(s).

Grantville Cemetery Business


- M. Riiska reported the grass Sean Muzzulin fertilized came back in good.
