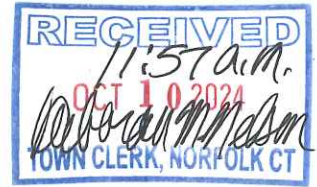


Cemetery Committee Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

*South Norfolk Cemetery*

- M. Riiska reported that Sepples Tree Service trimmed the tree at the back wall of the cemetery and removed dead branches.
- J. Gundlach provided pictures of old and broken gravestones that need repair, a broken stone at the rear wall of the cemetery near to entrance to the back and a sink hole near the front entrance. M. Riiska will talk to public works about repairs.
- M. Riiska put in a call regarding the granite posts but did not get a response. He will contact a local company.
- The two front gates to the old portion of the cemetery will be permanently closed off to vehicle traffic. There is no longer enough room to navigate a vehicle within this part of the cemetery.
- J. Gundlach provided pictures of a few graves that are caving in and need topsoil in the old section of the cemetery. M. Riiska will get public works to repair.
- J. Gundlach reported that the headstone for the Raymond plot has been returned. The family must have taken it out to have new dates engraved.
- J. Gundlach reported that the trees belonging the homeowners next door are hanging over the driveway into the back portion of the cemetery and need to be trimmed.

*Grantville Cemetery*

- Trees need to be trimmed near the obelisk as they are rubbing against the stone. The fence around it is also deteriorating.

*Pond Town Cemetery*

- Two broken flag holders need to be replaced on veteran's graves.
- Fence needs to be cleaned.
