Review of Project

Matt Glaser of Newfield Construction provided an update on the estimate.

Newfield needs updated site plans from Benesch Engineering to calculate the site work required once the old fire house is torn down.

Benesch needs to update Newfield about how surface and ground water will be handled during the construction of the new building considering the site will be very tight while the old fire house is still in use.

Discuss of pervious pavers; durability, especially during winter month maintenance. Pavers will most likely need to stay considering this was a condition of the Inland Wetlands Agency.

Funding Update

Waiting to hear from the State of CT regarding the recent STEAP application. The Town will be notified on April 3rd.
